By this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a direction to respondents no.2 and 3 to ensure protection of her life and liberty at the hands of respondents no.4 to 10, who are (as alleged) threatening her to face dire consequences, upon FIR no.148, dated 29.12.2019, having been registered at Police Station Women, Karnal, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 323/406/498-A/506 of the IPC.

She further seeks a direction to respondent no.2 to look into her representation dated 24.2.2021 (Annexure P-3), by conducting a fair investigation in the aforesaid FIR by some “higher official”.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage if a direction is issued to respondent no.2, i.e. the Superintendent of Police, Karnal, to take a decision on her representation (Annexure P-3), within a specified time frame.

Consequently, without making any comment whatsoever on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2, i.e. the SP, Karnal, to go into the matter and to take a action on the representation of the petitioner, if warranted, as per law, within a period of 1 month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, with it again made clear that this court has not made any comment as to whether the allegations made in the petition are correct or otherwise, which is a matter that would be gone into by the SP.
