The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3(1)(d) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoner Temporary Release Act, 1988 was filed seeking parole on the ground that petitioner is suffering from CORONA. He is 83 years old and is admitted in hospital.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Sher Singh, Superintendent Prison, District Prison, Sirsa, submits that the petitioner is seriously ill and is admitted in Jail Hospital. She further submits that he needs proper care and treatment.

In view of above, the petitioner is granted 4 weeks' parole from the date of his release, thereafter, he shall surrender before the jail authorities as per jail manual.

The petition is disposed of.
