1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for intentional and willful defiance of order dated 28.01.2021 in CWP No. 20171 of 2020.
3. Learned counsel however contends that now pursuant to the order of this Court dated 28.01.2021 in CWP No. 20171 of 2020, the respondent has passed order dated 16.07.2021, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 16.07.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. Learned State counsel also submits that in view of order dated 16.07.2021, having been passed by the respondent pursuant to the order of this Court 28.01.2021 in CWP No. 20171 of 2020, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is called for against the respondent.

5. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel for the parties.

6. In view of the position noted above as well as order dated 16.07.2021, having been passed by the respondent, there is sufficient compliance with order dated 28.01.2021 in CWP No. 20171 of 2020, consequentially, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is called for against the respondent. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 16.07.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
