By these two petitions, the petitioners seek the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.008, dated 09.01.2019, having been registered at Police Station City-II, Malerkotla, District Sangrur, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 304/34 of the IPC.

The petitioner in CRM-M-20223 of 2020 having been ordered to be admitted to interim bail by this court upon her surrendering/appearing before the trial court and a similar order having been passed in the case of petitioner in CRM-M-7531 of 2020, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh, submits that the petitioners have been regularly

appearing before the trial court after they were admitted to interim bail.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, whatsoever, subject to the petitioners continuing to appear as and when summoned by the trial court, the interim orders passed in their favour are made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

The petitions are accordingly disposed of.
