Petitioner Rupinder Kaur has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer to direct respondent No.2 to consider the case of the petitioner for the posts of Social Science Mistress Post as per Advertisement Annexure P-1 dated 09.09.2017 in SC & RO Ex-Serviceman Category instead of SC & RO Category, with a further prayer to direct the respondents to consider petitioner as SC(R&O) Ex-servicemen category candidate instead of SC(R&O) Category.

Records of the case show that vide order dated 24.07.2020, notice of motion was issued.

Today, on resumed hearing of the case, learned counsel for the petitioner submits orally that he may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition as substantial relief has been granted to the petitioner by

recruiting her subsequently.

An oral request of the petitioner is accepted.

Learned counsel also prays that in case, the petitioner is not permitted to join the new post, he may be given liberty to revive the present writ petition.
