This is a criminal writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

In the present case, notice of motion was issued and the detailed reply has been filed by the learned State counsel. As per the said reply, the petitioner is involved in 07 cases and further with respect to one FIR bearing No.361 dated 19.06.2020, under Sections 307, 34, 120-B and 216 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal, it was found necessary to join the petitioner in the investigation and after joining the petitioner in the investigation for 1 ½ hours, he was released.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the prayer of the petitioner is to the effect that the petitioner not be implicated in a false and fabricated case and be granted protection for his life and liberty.

Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, moreso, the fact that the petitioner is involved in 07 cases and also the fact that the petitioner was only called for 1 ½ hours for investigation in FIR No.361 dated 19.06.2020 and also the prayer sought to be made by the petitioner cannot possibly be granted, as there can be no injunction against an FIR, which may be registered in future against a person, thus, the present petition being devoid of merit is hereby dismissed.
