This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to arrest private respondents No.5 to 10 and to complete investigation in cross-version/GD No.30 dated 02.05.2021, under Sections 148, 323, 324 and 506 IPC read with Section 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) arising out of case FIR No.72 dated 02.05.2021, under Sections 148, 323, 324 and 506 IPC read with Section 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 20.06.2021 to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/3, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Harpreet Singh Multani, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, to look into and decide representation dated 20.06.2021 (Annexure P/3) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
