Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.32 dated 07.04.2021, under Sections 452, 323 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Abohar, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that only simple injuries were allegedly caused in the incident. The matter has been compromised. He has referred to the copy of the compromise at Annexure P4.

This Court, by the order dated 01.07.2021, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Bhagwan Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 01.07.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
