The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to official respondents to take legal action against the private respondents and to decide the representation dated 02.06.2021 moved to respondent No.11 and representation dated 18.06.2021 moved to respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that before filing representation to respondent No.2, petitioner gave a complaint to Police Station Jagatpuri Chownki, District Ludhiana on 02.06.2021. Petitioner has referred the material contents in para no.11 of the petition, but respondent No.11 did not take any action and therefore, requirement of Section 154 Cr.P.C. is fully complied with.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of calling upon any response from the respondents, as no order prejudicial to the interest of any party is being passed.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the representation of the petitioner dated 18.06.2021 without being influenced by any statement of fact, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
