Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this petition, the petitioner assails the correctness of the order passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Sirsa, directing him to pay an interim maintenance at the rate of Rs.6,000/- per month i.e Rs.3,000/- each for the respondent and her daughter. The learned Principal Judge has fixed the amount of interim maintenance after appreciating the facts on record. It has come on record that the petitioner herein earns about Rs.25,000/- to Rs.30,000/- per month by selling salty snacks.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the spread of COVID 19 pandemic has rendered the petitioner unemployed.

COVID-19 pandemic is a phase, which is likely to come to an end in near future.

The amount awarded cannot be said to be excessive.

Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
