The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.86 dated 28.05.2020 under Sections 354, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Batala, District Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, have joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State counsel, on instructions submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and that the matter has been investigated.

In view of the facts that the matter has been investigated and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 23.07.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
