This writ petition was entertained as learned counsel representing the petitioner has made a statement that the appellate authority, due to spread of COVID-19 pandemic is not holding the court. Learned counsel representing the petitioner admits that petitioner has a statutory remedy of filing an appeal. It is not in dispute that the appellate authority has now started entertaining and deciding the appeals.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petitioner is relegated to the alternative remedy. The writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file an appeal within a period of 15 days from today.
