The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 105 dated 12.07.2018, under Sections 323, 353, 186, 506 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is alleged that the petitioners had beaten up the officials of the Electricity Department, but there is no MLR. He also contends that there is a delay of five days in registering the FIR.

This Court, by the order dated 01.07.2021, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 01.07.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
