Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.75 dated 14.5.2021 registered under Sections 498-A, 323, 506, 109 I.P.C at Police Station, City-2 Mansa, District Mansa.

By virtue of the order dated 01.7.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the matter has been compromised between the parties and petitioner and the complainant are living together. Counsel further contends that in pursuance to the order dated 01.7.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.
