This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 8.5.2019 (Annexure P-11), passed by respondent No.5; orders dated 24.7.2020 (Annexure P-14) and 11.2.2021 (Annexure P-16), passed by respondent No.4. Further prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of directions to the respondents to revise/refix the pension of the petitioner in view of the Instructions dated 4.5.2015, 3.3.2017, 10.1.2018 and 24.7.2020.

Counsel for the State has submitted that the order passed against the petitioner has been modified and his retirement has been ordered to be treated as 'pre-mature retirement' with all consequential benefits attached to such pre-mature retirement. Hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

The counsel for the petitioner has also not disputed the fact qua

modification of the order. However, it is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that the consequent benefits have not been released to the petitioner so far.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered as infructuous. However, the respondents are directed to release the necessary benefits arising from the modified order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
