By way of the instant petition, the petitioner seeks the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to consider his representation (Annexure P-3) and to take action thereon in accordance with law and also to protect his life and liberty as he apprehends threat to the same at the hands of respondent No.4, who happens to be his real brother, while averring that they are having dispute over some piece of land and though he had moved representation (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2 for the redressal of his afore-narrated grievance but till date, no action has been taken in respect thereof.

Ms. Samina Dhir, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has joined the proceedings on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 in this case in pursuance of the copies of this petition having been sent to the

respondent-State in advance.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into his representation (Annexure P-3) only for the purpose of the protection of his life and liberty.

Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

Keeping in view the above-discussed limited prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting or expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter in hand, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, is hereby directed to look into the said representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-3) only qua the threat perception mentioned therein, for the purpose of the protection of his life and liberty and if it is found that the petitioner genuinely deserves any protection, then to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
