AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This writ petition was filed seeking protection for life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No. 7 to 10 and also respondent No. 6.

In the petition, it is pleaded that there was an incident of kidnapping of petitioner and loot of Rs.11,00,000/-, car and valuable documents on 10.5.2021.

Reply filed on behalf of respondents No. 1, 2 and 5.

Para No. 5 of the reply filed on behalf of respondents No. 1, 2 and 5 would be relevant which is quoted below:

“5. That it has been concluded in the aforesaid report that after conducting an enquiry through ASI-Sukhwinder Singh, it has been found that on 11.5.2021, the petitioner and the private respondents No. 7 to 10 had a verbal dispute with respect to the exchange of money and the allegations of the petitioner with respect to the alleged snatching were not proved. ASI-Sukhwinder Singh had recorded a DDR No. 27 dated 11.5.2021 in that respect. The true translations of the Report dated 15.7.2021 submitted by the S.H.O. of the Police

Station Khilchain, Amritsar (Rural) is attached herewith for the kind perusal of this Court as Annexure R-1/T.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the reply filed, he may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
