The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for production of detenue namely Mrs. Jaspreet Kaur, wife of the petitioner, who according to the petitioner has been illegally detained by her parents- respondent Nos. 4 to 6.

Notice in the present case was issued and the State was directed to file status report and also to produce the detenue before the learned Magistrate for recording of her statement, so that the truthful position can be ascertained.

An affidavit has been filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur and it has been stated that pursuant to the orders passed by this Court, the alleged detenue

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Jaspreet Kaur was produced before the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sangrur on 22.07.2021 and her statement was recorded. In her statement, she has stated that she got married with Gurpreet Singh (petitioner) on 18.03.2021 but he had misled her and after getting married she came back to her home in the evening and the petitioner had started threatening her and also started demanding money and so she was scared and she informed her parents about marriage after 6-7 days. It is further stated by her that she does not want to go with the petitioner. The statement of the detainee has also been attached as Annexure R-1.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The present petition has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus by the petitioner on the ground that his wife namely Jaspreet Kaur is in illegal detention of her parents. The alleged detainee is of the age of 22 years and is major. She has stated before the learned Magistrate that she does not want to go with the petitioner and has given reasons for the same.

In view of the affidavit filed by the State and the statement recorded by the alleged detainee Jaspreet Kaur, no interference is required in the present petition and consequently, the same is hereby dismissed.
