This Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 27.06.2021 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, District Mansa, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/2, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion confined to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, District Mansa, to look into and decide representation dated 27.06.2021 (Annexure P/2) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
