Case heard by way of video conferencing.

This petition has been filed seeking quashing, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners and respondents no.2 and 3, of FIR no.70 dated 08.03.2021 (as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom), registered at Police Station Division 'B', Amritsar, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 307 and 34 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, with Sections 27/54/59 thereof added subsequently in the FIR.

After arguing for some time, when this court was not agreeing as regards the quashing of the FIR even on the basis of any compromise arrived at between the parties, looking at the allegations made in the FIR, of a fire arm having been used and an offence punishable under Section 307 having been alleged to have been committed, and in view of the ratio of the judgments of the Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**, 2014 (2) RCR (CrI.) 482 and **State of**

Madhya Pradesh v. Laxmi Narayan and others, 2019 (2) RCR (Crl.) 255,

learned counsel seeks to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is made clear that this court has not made any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, which naturally would be subject of investigation and thereafter of evidence led before the trial court (if it comes to that stage).
