Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 50 dated 16.05.2021, under Sections 458, 440, 506, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the car being driven by the petitioner had broken the gate of the house of the complainant and the complainant was threatened. He also contends that there was no physical scuffle. The car had hit the gate accidentally and the petitioner, without prejudice to his rights and contentions, has paid a sum of Rs.25,000/- to the complainant on 09.10.2021.

This Court, by the order dated 01.07.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting

Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gurdev Singh, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but he is not cooperating.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 01.07.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
