Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent no.3, i.e. the DSP, Kartarpur, Jalandhar Rural, is time and again threatening the petitioner to settle the matter with respondents no.5 to 10, which is a purely civil dispute, in respect of which a civil suit is already pending.

He submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the SSP, Jalandhar (Rural), to take a decision on his representation dated 28.05.2021 (copy Annexure P-2) within a specified time frame.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case whatsoever, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the said respondent to take a decision on the aforesaid representation of the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It is made clear that in the meanwhile the petitioner or his family members shall not be harassed by the police and if they are to be

summoned for any investigation etc. (if any formal complaint is lodged against the petitioner or his family members), such investigation shall be done only within the four corners of law by following due procedure as laid down in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
