B.S. Walia, J. (VC)

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Section 151 Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order dated 16.03.2021 in CWP No. 6005 of 2021.
3. Learned counsel contends that the respondent has passed order dated 23.07.2021 in terms of order dated 16.03.2021 in CWP No. 6005 of 2021, therefore the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 23.07.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners no action is called for under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 against the respondent. Accordingly, the
