This is a petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C., in case FIR No.112, dated 30.10.2019, under Sections 21, 25, 27, 27-A & 29 of the N.D.P.S. Act, registered at Police Station Special Task Force, District Mohali.

[2]. The petitioner has remained in detention in the present case for a period of 1 year, 4 months and 2 days since 21.11.2019.

[3]. Admittedly, no direct recovery was effected from the petitioner in the case. He, therefore, stands at par with co-accused, namely, Harpal Kaur, who has already been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-14072-2020 on 19.06.2020, from whom an amount of ₹92,000/- claimed to be drug money was allegedly recovered. There is no record of his involvement in any other case under the N.D.P.S. Act.

[4]. Considering the overall circumstances of the case and treating the case of petitioner on the same parity as that of his above-named co-

accused, the prayer of the petitioner for his release on regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
