The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to the official respondents to transfer the investigation of case FIR No.150 dated 28.03.2021 registered under Section 498-A, 304-B, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 from the concerned police station to any other police station.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has restricted his prayer to issuance of directions to the official respondents to look into the representations both dated 10.06.2021 (Annexure P-2 and P-3) at the earliest since he is being pressurized to effect a compromise with the accused presence.

In the circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate direction is issued to respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Nuh, to look into the applications dated 10.06.2021 (Annexure P-2 and P-3) submitted by the

petitioner and take appropriate action under the provisions of law.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Ranjana Shahi, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed by the learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Nuh is directed to look into the grievance as stated out in the applications dated 10.06.2021 (Annexure P-2 and P-3) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps/action, if any, required under the provisions of law.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
