Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.38 dated 04.03.2020, under Sections 315, 120-B of Indian Penal Code and subsequently added Section 312 IPC; Section 18-A/18-C of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and Section 15(2) of Indian Medical Council Act, at Police Station Mohkampura, Amritsar.

Vide order dated 13.07.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 13.07.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and the same is affirmed by learned State counsel that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further custodial interrogation.
