For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed and date of hearing is postponed from 14.09.2021 to today.

CRM stands disposed of.

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Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.2 dated 02.01.2021 under Sections 379-B, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per allegations

in the FIR, registered at the instance of Bittu Sachdeva wife of Sandeep Sachdeva, when she was coming to the shop, carrying a polythene bag containing Rs.5900/-, two mobile phones of Vivo company and Samsung company and some other documents, two motorcyclists came and snatched her polythene bag and fled away. Later on, the petitioners and other accused were arrested and it was found that the petitioners, who are real brothers, were involved in the incident. Petitioner No.1 Jasbir Singh was driving the motorcycle and co-accused Vicky snatched the polythene bag from the complainant. Petitioner No.2 Gurjeet Singh @ Geeta was also a party to the criminal conspiracy. It is further submitted that the petitioners are in custody for the last about 07 months and are not involved in any other case.

Status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dabwali is on record, in which it is stated that during the investigation, both the petitioners were arrested and snatched property i.e. mobile phones, cash and motorcycle used in the commission of offence were recovered. It is further stated that as per disclosure statement of petitioner No.1 Jasbir Singh, he along with other accused has committed the offence and he got Rs.2900/- in cash, petitioner No.2 Gurjeet Singh @ Geeta got one mobile phone make Samsung, whereas co-accused Jinder Singh has taken mobile phone make Vivo and another co-accused Vicky has taken Rs.3000/- in cash. Thereafter, they had gone to their village on the motorcycle. It is further stated that the case is now fixed for recording the prosecution evidence and statement of the complainant is yet to be recorded.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, considering the

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serious allegations levelled in the FIR, I find no ground to grant regular bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
