The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance writ for directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Reply filed on behalf of respondent Nos.4 to 6 is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has referred to the report of SHO Police Station, Guhla, who has stated that as per statements of respondent Nos.4 to 6 they have no objection to the said relationship of the petitioners and nor they would give any threat to the petitioners and it has been found that there is no danger to the petitioners' life and liberty.

Keeping in view, the above-said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered as infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to move a representation before respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police,

Kaithal in case of any apprehension regarding threat perception of life and liberty in future and in case such a representation is moved then respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

Disposed of in the above-said terms.
