The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 199 dated 20.06.2020, under Sections 353, 186, 332 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner and his family members had an altercation with the staff of the civil hospital with regard to the admission of his wife, who was in advanced stage of pregnancy. The child had died immediately after delivery. Only simple injuries, including abrasions, were allegedly caused in the incident.

This Court, by the order dated 02.07.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Naveen Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 02.07.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
