The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0047 dated 25.05.2021, under Sections 452, 325, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner are bailable except the offence punishable under Section 452 IPC. The injuries are on the non-vital parts of the body of the complainant and the injured.

Heard.

It is alleged that the petitioner along with several other persons had trespassed into the house of the complainant and caused injuries to her and her daughter-in-law. The alleged motive for the incident is also attributed to the petitioner, as raid had been conducted at his premises at the instance of

the complainant with regard to illicit liquor and the petitioner suspected the complainant. The petitioner and others had trespassed into the house of the complainant and had caused injuries to her and her daughter-in-law which resulted in a fracture as well. Therefore, I do not deem it to be a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
