This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to allot a plot under the Oustee Category as per policy dated 17.04.1974 (Annexure P-1).

Counsel, at the very outset, seeks withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to file a petition afresh but with better particulars.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn in terms of liberty as prayed for.
