The petitioners are alleged to have worked on current duty charge as Sub-Divisional Officer/Engineers from February, 2014 to June, 2016. The petitioners were regularly promoted to the post of Sub-Divisional Engineer in June, 2016. Through this petition, the petitioners claim salary for the period they have worked as Sub-Divisional Engineers on the current duty charge.

From reading of the order (Annexure P1), it is apparent that the petitioners were clearly informed in advance that they shall not be entitled to any benefit i.e. pay scale, salary, allowance and seniority for the period for which they worked on current duty charge basis. Clause 3 of the order dated 26.02.2014 is extracted as under:-

“The above officials shall not be entitled any benefits i.e.

*Pay scale/salary/allowance/seniority etc. of the post of Sub
Divisional Officer.”*

It is not in dispute that the petitioners have already been paid

the salary after they were regularly promoted to the said post in June, 2016.

This writ petition has been filed in the year 2021. The petition also suffers from unexplained delay and latches. Even a civil suit would not be maintainable at this stage.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to issue the writ is made out.

Dismissed.
