1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Order dated 23.06.2021 passed by the respondent in compliance of order dated 16.03.2021 in CWP No.5983 of 2021 has been produced by learned State Counsel. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, he does not press the contempt petition and the petition may be disposed of, as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 23.06.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
3. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel for the parties.

4. Admittedly, order dated 23.06.2021 has been passed by the respondent in compliance of order dated 16.03.2021 in CWP No.5983 of 2021. Accordingly, there being sufficient compliance with order dated 16.03.2021 in CWP No. 5983 of 2021, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent.

5. In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of, as not calling for any action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 against the respondent, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 23.06.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
