This is a criminal writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

On 06.07.2021, a Coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Case taken up through video conferencing.

Notice of motion.

Mr. J.S. Ghuman, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent -State.

Let service of respondents No.4 to 7 be got effected through ordinary process, registered AD post, courier service

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*and through electronic means by the next date of hearing,
fixed as 25.08.2021.*

*In the meanwhile, Senior Superintendent of Police,
Sangrur is directed to take necessary steps to ensure that no
physical harm is caused to the petitioner at the hands of
private respondents or persons claiming under them.*

06.07.2021”

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has got her statement recorded on 14.07.2021 in the inquiry proceedings being conducted by ASI Harminder Singh, Police Station Sadar, Sangrur, to the effect that at present, she is not apprehending any danger to her life from the private respondents and that she does not need any protection.

Keeping in view the above said facts, moreso, the statement of the petitioner dated 14.07.2021, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.

However, in case the petitioner has any such apprehension in future, she can make a representation to respondent No.2 and respondent No.2, after considering the threat perception, is direction to look into the same and if required, take appropriate action, in accordance with law.
