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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

It is the case of petitioners that private respondent No. 6 had entered into an agreement to sell with respect to some parcel of land with petitioner No. 1. As they did not honour said agreement to sell, petitioner No. 1 instituted a civil suit for specific performance which has been decreed in his favour. Private respondent No. 6 has filed an appeal against said decree which has been dismissed. Private respondent No. 6 has also filed Regular Second Appeal which has also been dismissed.

Having lost in civil proceedings, private respondent No. 6 has filed a complaint against petitioners. Pursuant to that complaint, petitioners are harassed by respondents No. 4 and 5. They are being repeatedly called to Anti Fraud Cell for the last 1 ½ years. They are made to sit there for hours. Petitioners have submitted all documents and information required by respondents No. 4 and 5. Respondents No. 4 and 5 are threatening to involve the petitioners in a criminal case.

Considering the aforesaid, this petition is disposed of with a direction to official respondents that in case, presence of petitioners is required in connection with any inquiry, complaint and investigation, proper procedure as contemplated in Code of Criminal Procedure be followed.
