These are the two petitions filed on behalf of the petitioners for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.49, dated 15.02.2021, under Sections 147/149/323/365/379-B/506 of the IPC (Sections 367/201/34 of the IPC added in Challan in CRM-M-25552-2021),

registered at Police Station Sadar Narwana, Jind.

2. Both the petitioners have remained in detention for more than nine months, since 18.02.2021. After completion of investigation, Challan against them have already been submitted. Even the statement of complainant/victim-Deepak as witness from the prosecution side has already been recorded, apart from the evidence of two other prosecution witnesses. Thirteen more prosecution witnesses remain to be examined, on account of which, the trial is likely to take some time to conclude.

3. Ld. Counsel for the complainant/victim submits that he has no objection if the petitioners are released on bail, considering that the petitioners and the complainant are close neighbors and the dispute between both the parties has already been resolved.

4. In view of the above, without commenting any further on merits of the present cases as a whole and considering the detention undergone by the petitioners, their prayer for regular bail is allowed and they are ordered to be released on bail, subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
