Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.89 dated 21.6.2019 under section 376 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Adampur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that no offence as alleged in the FIR is made out against the petitioner. He has further contended that the complainant has also entered into a compromise with the petitioner and thus the false implication of petitioner is *writ large*.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. M.S. Nagra learned A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and Mr. Arun Sharma, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of complainant.

Though, counsel for the complainant has not denied the contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioner, however, learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that the petitioner has been declared Proclaimed Offender in this case and thus the prayer is not acceptable.

I am totally in agreement with the arguments raised by learned State counsel and thus, do not find any ground to accept the prayer made in the present petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
