The prayer in the present writ petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia* is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to take a decision on the pending charge-sheet bearing no.183/D-11754 dated 23.07.2020 (Annexure P-1) in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that at this stage he limits his prayer and would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent no.2 to decide the pending charge-sheet dated 23.07.2020 (Annexure P-1) in a time bound manner since his promotion is dependent on the outcome of the said enquiry.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sehajbir Singh, Advocate, who has joined the session through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He, on instructions from Er. Devinder Pal Singh,

Executive Engineer (Presenting Officer), states that the pending enquiry would be concluded within a period of four months from today and he has no objection if the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent no.2 to conclude the enquiry within the said period.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the stand taken by learned counsel for the respondents and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent no.2 to take a decision on the charge-sheet dated 23.07.2020 (Annexure P-1), in accordance with law, expeditiously and in any case within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Disposed off accordingly.
