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**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)**

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.99 dated 14.10.2020, under Sections 307, 323, 506 and 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Bahin, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner had fired a solitary gun shot which had hit the injured Gopal Kishan near the shoulder. Injured was discharged from the hospital after 03 days and has fully recovered from the injury. He also contends that the complainant namely Mam Chand and injured namely Gopal Krishan examined as PW-1 and PW-2 did not support the prosecution case qua the involvement of the petitioner. He has furnished copies of the statements of PW-1 and PW-2 which are taken on record. He also contends that the petitioner is working as a Beldar in the Irrigation Department and is the sole breadwinner of his family. The petitioner is in custody for over 01 year and 01 month and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel has filed custody certificate which indicates that the petitioner is in custody for 01 year and 01 month. He upon instructions states that 02 out of 16 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 01 year and 01 month, he is not involved in any other case, injured and the complainant have not supported the prosecution case, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
