The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners who claim to have served under the respondents as teachers in the schools being run by the respondents and perturbed over the non-consideration of their services rendered by them in privately managed Government Aided School before joining the present assignment in Government service and, thus, has deprived them of their plea of continuity in service as well as calculation of pension, senior/selection grade etc. and on the basis same has come in

this civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *mandamus*.

Heard.

Be so as it may, the petitioners are directed to first move the respondents by way of representation and upon their doing so would be disposed off by respondents within one month and being not considered shall have the right to approach this Court, thereafter.
