Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.79 dated 05.06.2021 registered under Sections 323, 341, 342, 365, 506, 149 IPC at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that since Rani has been released from the State After Home, Amritsar, the petitioners may be granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

Considering the fact that the FIR has been registered out of

a dispute arising out of the marriage of Rani, daughter of petitioner No.4 with the complainant – Ranija and the petitioners have already sworn the affidavit that they will not interfere in the life of Rani, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to appear before the Investigating Officer within a period of 10 days to join investigation and they shall be released on interim bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. They shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2. They shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and*
- 3. They shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.*
