At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order dated 05.02.2020 passed in CWP No.1181 of 2017 having been stayed by Hon'ble the Division Bench in LPA No.520 of 2020, he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn, at this stage, with liberty to file a fresh contempt petition, if the circumstances of the case so warrant.

3. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is ***dismissed as withdrawn*** with the liberty, as prayed for.
