The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.178 dated 06.09.2020, under Sections 307, 392 IPC, registered at Police Station Jodhewal, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner tried to rob cousin of the complainant and inflicted a knife blow on his neck. The petitioner is 21 year of age and is in custody for over 10 months. He is not involved in any other case. He also contends that the petitioner was allegedly arrested at the spot and badly beaten up.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar, contends that challan has been filed but no witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is 21 year of age, he is not involved in any other criminal case, he is in custody for over 10 months, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
