This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioners for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to take action against respondents No.3, 5, 6 and 7 who are harassing the petitioners in an illegal manner at the behest of private respondents No.8 and 9; to protect the life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of respondents No.3, 5, 6 and 7 and to take action on representation dated 15.06.2021 (Annexure P-9).

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation on 15.06.2021 to Director General of Police, Punjab, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/9, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1, 2 and 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. H.S. Multani, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1, 2 and 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 – Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh, to look into and decide representation dated 15.06.2021 (Annexure P/9) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
