The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect his life and liberty from harassment at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6 at the behest of respondents No.7 and 8. The petitioner has also sought further relief of directing respondents No.1 to 4 to look into the grievances of the petitioner and directing respondents No.5 and 6 not to involve him in any false case.

In compliance with order dated 28.07.2020, Status report by way of affidavit of Ravinderpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (D), Ferozepur has been filed on behalf of respondents No.2 to 5.

In the status report it has been mentioned that the petitioner or any or member of his family is not required by the police of District

Ferozepur.

Learned State Counsel submits that CIA Staff, Ferozepur being part of the police of District Ferozepur the petitioner is also not required by CIA Staff, Ferozepur.

In view of statement of learned State Counsel, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not want to continue with the present petition as no further action is required and the same may be disposed of accordingly.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of accordingly.
