Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing inaction of the respondents in not considering the petitioners while making promotions of junior teachers vide order dated 03.08.2020 (P-10), in contravention of public notice dated 29.01.2019 (P-9) as well as the Statutory Rules. Further prayer is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to consider their claim for promotion to the post of English Master/Mistress w.e.f. 13.07.2018 (P-7).

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, states that her clients would be satisfied in case, legal notice dated 05.03.2021 (P-15) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the consensus arrived at between both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 05.03.2021 (P-15), in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of (06) six weeks from today.
