The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 i.e. official respondents to conduct fair enquiry and register FIR against respondents No.4 to 6 expeditiously on the complaint (Annexure P-1).

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is married with respondent No.4 and it was a arranged marriage and at the time of marriage when she was asked about her age, she gave him her matriculation certificate as her age proof which he accepted under trust. He wanted to add his wife as a nominee in the company's employment data in this connection and when she was asked about age proof, she started dilly dallying. He submitted that the relationship thereafter become sour and she is not even taking care of his parents and rather demanding huge amount of money from them. He has further

submitted that a complaint was given to the Police Commissioner, Ludhiana for taking action and registering FIR against the private respondents.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Ex-facie the petition seems to be totally frivolous in nature. A perusal of the representation Annexure P-1 would show that for a pure and simple matrimonial dispute, the petitioner is seeking to invoke extraordinary jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. Such kind of direction cannot be issued under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure wherein the grievance of the petitioner is that his wife had lied to him with regard to her age and her refusal to take care of his parents. No such direction can be issued to the police for taking action against the private respondents for such a grievance for registration of the FIR.

Consequently, the present petition is, hereby, dismissed.
