Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has information that the parties have entered into a settlement. However, he prays for some time to verify this fact.

Sh. Dinesh Arora, learned counsel appearing for the respondent, submits that a settlement has been arrived at between the parties which has been signed by the parties. It is agreed that the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending before the Principal Judge, Family Court, Rohtak, shall be withdrawn by the respondent and a fresh petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, shall be filed before the court of competent jurisdiction at Jind.
