This is the second petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.45 dated 30.03.2020 lodged under Section 22, 29, 61 and 85 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station STF Mohali, District SAS Nagar (Mohali), Punjab.

Learned State counsel has placed on record a short reply by way of affidavit of Sukhamrit Singh Randhawa, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, STF, Patiala Range, Patiala through e-mail. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, while inviting the attention of this Court to the medical opinion given by the doctor of Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot, has submitted that when the child of the petitioner was taken to GGS Medical College Faridkot for his medical examination, the doctor had given a categoric opinion that the child did not require any surgical intervention. Learned State counsel has submitted that

in fact at best it is a dermatological problem which the child is facing. Learned State counsel has further submitted that during the medical examination of the child of the petitioner, no other serious medical ailment had come to the notice of the doctors concerned and rather it had been specifically stated that his condition was satisfactory and he could follow it up with visits to the OPD.

In the circumstances and in the wake of the medical report attached with the reply filed by the learned State counsel, no ground is made to extend the concession of bail to the petitioner. In view thereof, the present petition stands dismissed.
