The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This petition in the nature of Habeas Corpus was filed seeking production of the detainee (name withheld considering the sensitivity of the proceedings).

In pursuance of notice of motion issued, learned State counsel has filed a short reply by way of an affidavit of Paramjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Phagwara, District Kapurthala through electronic medium. Print out of the same is taken on record.

Para Nos. 3 and 4 of the reply are relevant, which reproduced as under:-

“3. That it is humbly submitted that it was verified by SI Gurjeet Kaur Incharge Police Post Panshat, PS Rawalpindi

that Pardip Kaur daughter of private respondents was not kept detained by them in any manner and as per statement of detenue Pardip Kaur, her marriage was fixed for 6.7.2021 with her consent and the petitioner is harassing her and her family members.

4. That it is humbly submitted that the SHO PS Rawalpindi also instructed the daily duty officer and PCR Police Officials to keep vigil on the house of the detenue Pardip Kaur so that nobody can interfere in the marriage of the detenue Pardip Kaur on 6.7.2021. It is relevant to mention that as per verification of the local police, the marriage of the petitioner has been performed on 6.7.2021 without any interference and the detenue Pardip Kaur is residing her matrimonial home.”

In view of reply filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing with the present petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.
